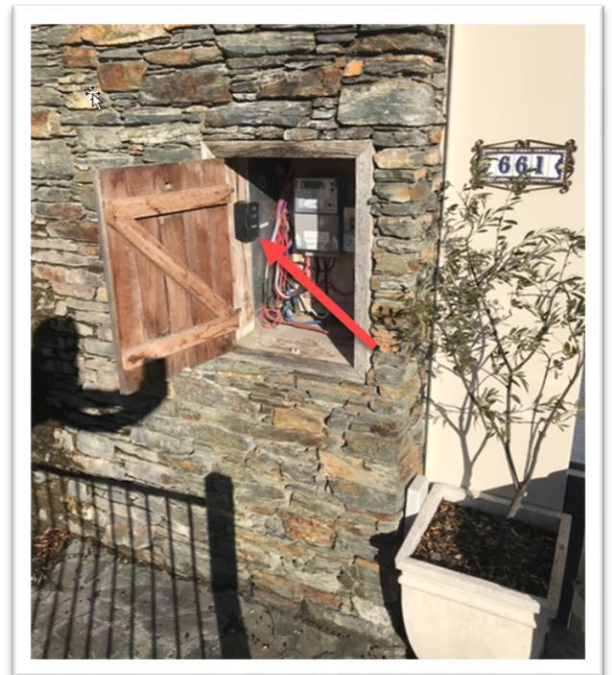
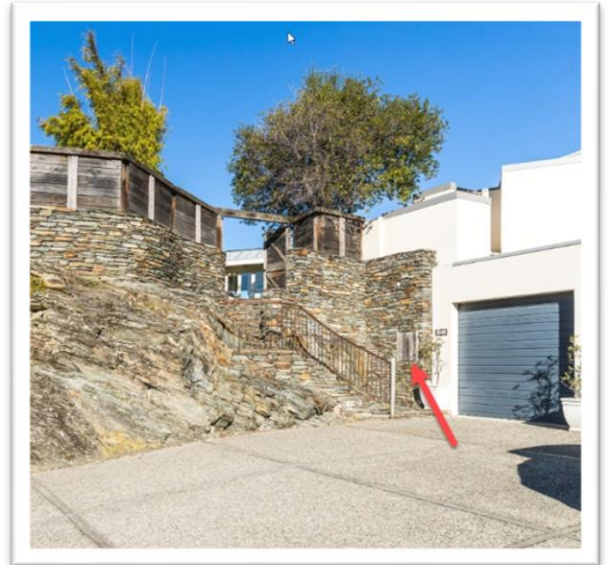

1. CHECK IN

Hello

- **Check in time** is from 3pm
- **Lockbox:** To enter the house when you arrive, first retrieve the key from the lock box at the bottom of the outdoor steps on the wall in the electrical box. Enter the 4-digit code you were given, then proceed up the stairs through the wooden gates & private garden courtyard to the front door.
- **Quiet hours:** are between 10pm-8am, out of respect to the neighbors.
- **Security:** When leaving the house during your stay, please ensure all doors and windows are locked and the front door is deadlocked for security.
- **Parking:** There is parking for up to 5 cars, 2 in the garage, and 3 on the driveway. Garage door opener remote will be on the master keyring in lockbox.



2. CHECK OUT

and goodbye

- Check out time is 10am
- Please put any rubbish & recycling in the bins located in the garage (The recycling bin is yellow and blue, the general rubbish bin is red)
- Put used towels in the laundry baskets provided or leave on the bathroom floor
- Return any furniture that was moved to its original position and return any items used (games, TV remotes etc)
- Please make sure all lights are turned off and the windows and doors are locked
- Please turn off the heating or air conditioning before leaving
- Lock the front door and return the key to the lock box.

4. HEATING/COOLING

Climate change, it's a thing

Twin peaks has both heating and air conditioning. To turn on the heating/cooling use the remotes provided.

Upstairs living area: There are two heat pumps and a gas fire.



Heat pump 1 is in the centre of the room

Heat pump 2 is located in the cupboard on the right-hand side of the wood fireplace. On chilly days, two heat pumps keep the area lovely and warm.

Please note: The wood fire is ornamental only, no fires are to be lit.

The gas fire on the opposite side of the room can be lit by removing the metal grate at bottom and turning the dial.

The upstairs bedrooms and downstairs lounge have heating/cooling. The downstairs bedrooms have heating.

5. SPA POOL

If you fancy a soak

The spa pool is covered with a lockable lid. To use the spa simply unbuckle and remove the cover, and replace when you are finished.

No glass in or near the spa pool please. For the safety of you and other guests please use the plastic glasses provided (located on the shelves above the coffee maker).



6. LAKE WAKATIPU

Lake walk track access

WALKING (2-3 mins): To access the lake, turn left as you walk out the Twin Peaks driveway until you get to the next driveway (Alpine Apartments). Go down the driveway (which is public access), until you reach the steps which will take you directly to the track.

Once you're on the track, left will take you to Frankton, right to Queenstown.

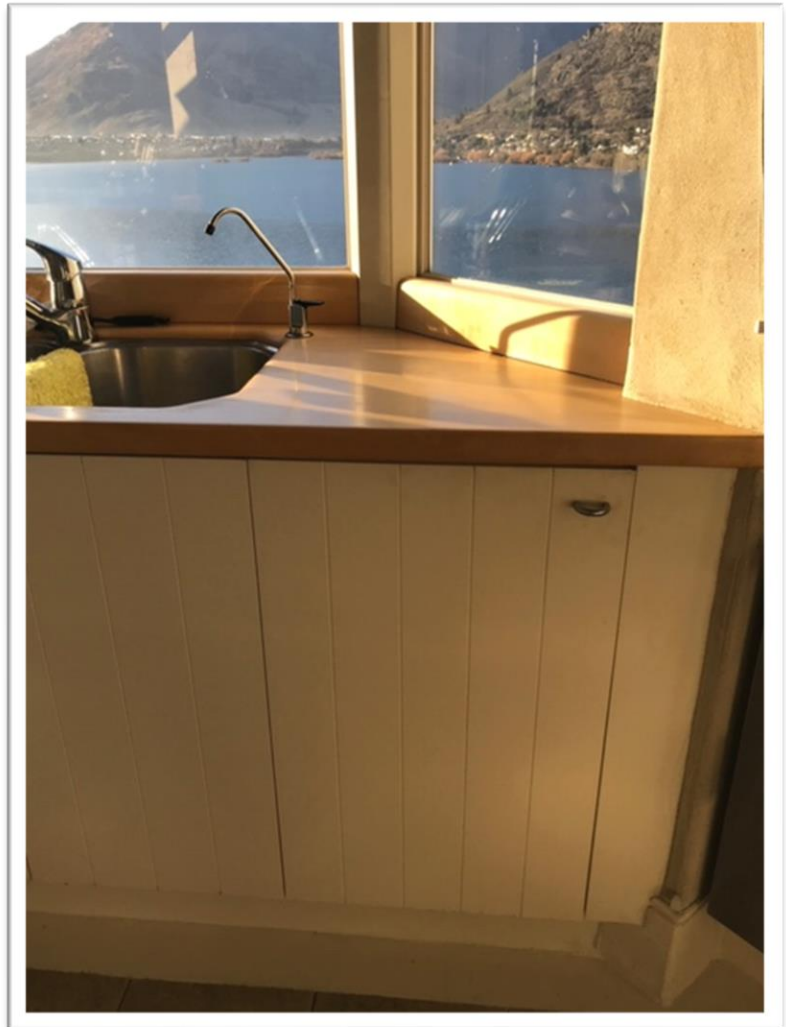


7. RUBBISH

The rubbish bin is located in the kitchen cupboard to the right of the sink. Before checking out, please put all recyclable materials in the recycle bin, all trash in the trash bin, both which are located in the garage.

The garbage disposal in the sink can handle small amounts of food scraps, but please put the majority of food scraps in the rubbish.
